

The Gospel of God Romans 1:1-7

- I. **The gospel of God transforms those who believe it (1:1).**
 - It creates a relationship to Jesus Christ.
 - It creates new responsibilities.
 - II. **The gospel of God was promised in the Old Testament (1:2).**
 - God has announced and accomplished this gospel.
 - This gospel is grounded in eternity past and in the Old Testament.
 - III. **The gospel of God is the Lord Jesus Christ (1:3-4).**
 - Jesus Christ was a true human being.
 - IV. **The gospel of God is to be proclaimed to all people everywhere (1:5).**
 - Only God's grace can overcome human rebellion.
 - It is God's grace that makes us His ambassadors.
 - V. **The gospel of God will bear the fruit of new creatures in Christ (1:6-7).**
 - Believers in Christ are loved by God the Father.
 - Believers in Christ were called to be believers by God.
 - Believers in Christ are saints.
 - Believers in Christ need massive amounts of grace and peace.
- Jesus Christ was declared to be the Son of God by His resurrection from the dead.
