## Storing Up Wrath Rom. 2:5-11

- I. When God's grace is rejected God's wrath is inflicted (v. 5).
  - > What does a stubborn and unrepentant heart look like?
  - > When is the day of wrath? What will it be like?
  - > How are you testing the limits of God's patience?
- II. The wrath of God would not be inflicted if it were possible to persist in doing good (vv. 6-7).
  - > What does it mean to seek "glory, honor, and immortality?"
  - > What principle is Paul dealing with here?
  - > How can doing good lead to eternal life?

- The wrath of God will be inflicted upon those who do 111. evil works (vv. 8-11).
  - > Is Paul saying that people can gain salvation by works?
  - > What case is Paul building in this section of Romans (2:6, 11, 13; 3:9-19, 20)?
  - > Whose judgment is impartial?
