

## **Storing Up Wrath** **Rom. 2:5-11**

I. When God's grace is rejected God's wrath is inflicted (v. 5).

- ▶ What does a stubborn and unrepentant heart look like?
  
- ▶ When is the day of wrath? What will it be like?
  
- ▶ How are you testing the limits of God's patience?

II. The wrath of God would not be inflicted if it were possible to persist in doing good (vv. 6-7).

- ▶ What does it mean to seek "glory, honor, and immortality?"
  
- ▶ What principle is Paul dealing with here?
  
- ▶ How can doing good lead to eternal life?

III. The wrath of God will be inflicted upon those who do evil works (vv. 8-11).

- ▶ Is Paul saying that people can gain salvation by works?
  
- ▶ What case is Paul building in this section of Romans (2:6, 11, 13; 3:9-19, 20)?
  
- ▶ Whose judgment is impartial?
