- I. God has given Israel the privilege of the possession of the covenant with Abraham (3:1-2).
 - > What promises have been given by God to Israel?
 - What blessings have come to the Gentiles through Israel?
 - > Is Israel still God's chosen people?
- II. God will forever remain true to His promises to Israel (3:3-4).
 - What does sin do to the relationship between God and the believer?
 - Have God's promises to the Jews been cancelled because of Jewish unbelief?
 - ➤ How can David's experience of disobedience be of help to us?
- III. God does not take pleasure in sin (3:5-6).
 - > What did God do in response to Israel's unbelief?

- Why does God judge man if God is proved faithful by man's sin?
- IV. God's provision of grace will be distorted by sinful human beings (3:7-8).
 - > Why is there opposition to God's grace?
 - ➤ Does grace mean that one can be saved, then go out the next day and commit any sin he wants to?
