## "Heirs of the World by Faith" Romans 4:13-16

- I. Abraham received the promise of Messianic blessings by faith alone (v. 13).
  - A. The promise to Abraham was not based on the Mosaic Law.
  - B. Man was created to be the king of the earth, but Adam forfeited this rule. Satan usurped this rule.
  - C. Jesus Christ is the promised seed of Abraham who regained what Adam lost. He owns the earth. Jesus Christ is the King of the earth.

- II. The promise of Messianic blessing would not be realized if it had been given on a law-works basis (vv. 14-15).
  - A. If the principle of law-works were the condition for Messianic blessings the character of God would be called into question.

B. If the principle of law-works were the condition for Messianic blessings, everyone would be shut-out from their enjoyment.

## III. The promise of Messianic blessings can be enjoyed only by the grace of God (v. 16).

- A. Grace is the only basis there is for a secure future in Christ.
- B. Believing Jews and Gentiles will enjoy the blessings of God's covenant with Abraham.
