

Who Raised Jesus?

Romans 8:11

I. Jesus Christ was raised from the dead by God the Father (Acts 2:24; Rom. 6:4; 1 Cor. 6:14; Gal. 1:1; Eph. 1:20).

II. Jesus Christ raised Himself from the dead (Jn. 10:17-18; 2:19-21).

- Jesus said, “I am the resurrection and the life” (Jn. 11:25; Heb. 7:16).

III. Jesus Christ was raised from the dead by the Holy Spirit (Rom. 8:11).

IV. The resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead is a pledge of our resurrection (Rom. 8:11; 1 Cor. 15:20).

- When will we receive our resurrection body?

- Will we recognize one another in heaven?
- Will our bodies bear scars and other physical imperfections in heaven?
- Will we need or want food and rest in our resurrection bodies?
- Will we have to deal with sin in our resurrection bodies (e.g. sinful thoughts, motives)?
- Will we be spirits or flesh and bones?
- Will non-Christians receive a resurrection body (Rev. 20:5)?
