- I. The love of Christ for us is not threatened by any of the miseries of this life (v. 35).
 - Tribulation
 - Distress

- II. The love of Christ for us is proven by His Word not by our experiences (v. 36). ("Just as it is written" Psa. 44:22)
 - Christ never loves His people more than when He allows them the honor to suffer for Him.

- III. The love of Christ for us is proven by His sufferings for us (v. 37).
 - How can we be "more" than a conqueror?
- IV. The love of Christ for us overcomes every adversary and adversity that is raised up against us (vv. 38-39).

 - Principalities
 - Things present
 - Things to come
 - Powers
 - Height
 - Depth
 - Any created thing
