- V. No one does good (“All have turned aside, together they have become useless; there is none who does good, there is not even one.” v. 12).
 - When did human beings take the wrong turn?
 - Why can’t human beings do good things?

- VI. Everyone has a mouth that dishonors God (3:13-14).
 - In what ways does the human tongue bite like a rattlesnake?

- VII. Everyone lives at war with everyone else (3:15-17).
 - How do human beings destroy and ruin one another?

- VIII. Everyone is in rebellion against God (v. 18).
 - What is wrong with the thinking of human beings?
 - What do human beings fear instead of God?

- IX. Everyone needs God’s righteousness (3:19-20).
 - If God were to say to you, “What right do you have to come into my heaven?” What would you say?
 - Why can no one be declared righteous in God’s sight by observing the law?
