"Justification as a Gift" Romans 3:24

Introduction

What is justification?

- ➤ It is a legal declaration by God (Lk. 7:29; Rom. 8:33-34).
- ➤ It is a legal declaration that God has forgiven our past sins and that we are treated as righteous in His sight (Rom. 8:1).
- ➤ It is a legal declaration that God has forgiven our past sins and that we are righteous in His sight because He imputes Christ's righteousness to us.
- I. We are saved by the payment of Christ's life in death as a substitute for us as sinners.
 - ➤ Redemption The work of Christ on the cross involved the payment of a price.

- II. We are saved by what Christ has done for us not by what we do for Christ.
 - > As a gift justification is without a cause in the sinner.
 - By His grace Grace is God's love in action toward sinners.

- III. We are saved by trusting in Jesus Christ as a living person for the forgiveness of sins and eternal life with God.
 - > God justifies us through our faith in Christ.
 - > We are saved by faith alone.
