

“One Way or Many Ways to God?”
Romans 3:27-31

- I. Salvation by grace through faith alone excludes all human boasting (vv. 27-28).
 - God’s way of salvation humbles us.

 - God’s way of salvation is not by keeping any legal system.

- II. Salvation by grace through faith alone is an example of the unity of God (vv. 29-30).
 - One way of salvation for everybody is consistent with the character of God.

 - God does not have two methods of salvation. He deals with all people in the same way.

- III. Salvation by grace through faith alone establishes the law of God (v. 31).
 - The Mosaic law is upheld as a standard of God’s holiness, now fulfilled in Christ.
