## Amazed Angels 1 Peter 1:10-12

- I. THE OLD TESTAMENT PROPHETS SEARCHED LONG AND HARD TO GRASP THE MEANING OF THE MESSIAH'S SUFFERINGS AND GLORY (1:10-11).
  - A. The sufferings of Israel's Messiah are prophesied in the Old Testament (Gen. 3:15; Psa. 22:1, 7-8; Isa. 52 & 53; Zech. 9:9).

B. The glory of Israel's Messiah is predicted in the Old Testament (Psa. 2; Isa. 9:6; Dan. 7:13-14; Zech. 9:10).

- II. THE OLD TESTAMENT PROPHETS LEARNED BY REVELATION THAT THE FULFULLMENT OF THEIR PROPHECIES OF THE MESSIAH WOULD NOT OCCUR IN THEIR DAY (1:12).
